OLD BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS

Ball People - Valley Soccer Club has been contacted to supply ball boys/girls for all JV & Varsity home games. The volunteers will get a free t-shirt or free athletic pass to a fall sport.

Senior Night - Christine & Mary will get Junior girls to make posters for the Seniors. Making sure they are creative, positive and personal. Lisa will ask Sally if she will order balloons again, same as last year. Mary will ask a friend if she can take pictures of seniors, seniors with their parents, etc.

Banquet - Still looking at Thursday, Nov. 11th. Talked about using same caterer as last year. Need to decide but we like: meatballs & sausage, penne with sauce, baked chicken, baked ham, tossed salad. All players make desserts (except seniors). Since the Mum sale is usually a large fundraiser for the Banquet we will need to look very closely at the costs involved. Discussed possibly charging \$25-

per family. If the player sold Mums or did the buyout then the fee would be dropped to \$5-. We agreed to think about this and make decision next meeting.
